Uniform

Boys Uniform:

- A plain white Jubba no longer than the ankles (This must not have any embellishments or embroidery)
- Shalwar Kameez is not permitted
- A plain whiteT-shirt or vest under the Jubba
- Loose white izar or trousers (Jeans or jogging pants are not permitted)
- Any Colour Skull cap/tagiyah/kufi (Caps or other hats are not permitted)

Girls Uniform:

- A plain black closed Jilbab that covers the ankles (This must not have any embellishments or embroidery)
- Loose black trousers or shalwar (Leggings, jeans and jogging pants are not permitted)
- Any colour Al-Amirah style (pull on) hijab (Wrap around hijabs with pins are not permitted)

Support from Parents

Please ensure that children perform wudu before coming to class. Please supervise the children whilst they perform wudu.

Please help the children at home with supervised study time. Any queries regarding your child's work, please consult the subject teacher via telephone call or arrange a meeting.

All subjects have a booklet that the children will cover in class. Homework and tests will be written in children's homework diaries and Google Classroom, please ensure you check the planners and assist your child with homework and provide supervised study/revision time. Tajweed corrections and guidance notes will be written in their reading records book - please also look out for this and support your child/ren throughout the week. Please sign diaries weekly to acknowledge correspondence.
